

# Shopping Rules

Per CDC guidelines, Face Masks are optional. If you are unwell, please wear a face mask.

- ◆ Shoppers must currently be enrolled in high school. A Valid school ID card or other proof of current enrollment must be presented at time of visit.
- ◆ Student are required to make a personal shopping appointment in advance, by visiting [ywcaelgin.org/get-involved/events/cinderellas-closet/](http://ywcaelgin.org/get-involved/events/cinderellas-closet/). Unless prior arrangements have been made ahead of time by your school.
- ◆ Students will be assigned a personal shopper “fairy godmother” to help them shop for a dress. We will have private dressing rooms for each student, and you are allowed to try on up to 5 dresses at one time.
- ◆ Your \$25 donation includes a dress w/ limited accessories, ie jewelry, purse, shoes, etc. (while supplies last). Additional dresses may be purchased separately (without accessories included).
- ◆ Student shoppers will be limited to 1 hour in the boutique.
- ◆ Formal dresses often run small, so you may have to go up a size or two from your “street size” to find a dress that fits.
- ◆ CELL PHONE USAGE AND PICURE TAKING IS NOT ALLOWED ON THE BOUTIQUE FLOOR. NO FOOD or DRINKS PERMITTED.
- ◆ Each student will be allowed to bring ONE FEMALE guest with them into the boutique, to help them shop. No child under the age of 13 will be allowed into the boutique. There is no waiting area at the YWCA for additional guests, therefore they will need to wait in the car or outside. There are sandwich/coffee shops close by.
- ◆ No males are allowed into the boutique. Accommodations may be available for dads or adult male guardians who would like to view their daughter’s dress. Please contact the YWCA-Elgin to make arrangements.
